Development News



Andrew Dobson (Managing Director) and Simon Hawketts (Development Executive) of Crest Strategic Projects were at the recent Meet Your Neighbours event on Thursday 19th October, where they provided the following updates:

- **Pub Land:** Solicitors were instructed on Wednesday 18th October to sell the pub land to Arkell's Brewery. They have already instructed their architects to start working on a scheme that they hope to submit to Swindon Council for comment in the next few months with a full application to follow.
- **Retail Centre:** In conjunction with Crest Nicholson SW, we are in the process of preparing a reserved matters application for the retail centre and already have strong interest from a couple of the main supermarket chains for the convenience store element.
- **Sports Facilities:** We await a final proposal for FC Abbey Meads in conjunction with the local cricket club to manage the sports facilities onsite.
- Medical Centre: We are waiting for the local GP surgery's to confirm whether or not they can accommodate what they need on the land being provided and will advise accordingly. Availability of parking is the major issue here.
- Nature Park: A meeting has taken place with Wiltshire Wildlife Trust who are very keen to regularise an agreement with the CIC to be funded to manage, improve and provide learning opportunities for the Nature Park on behalf of the residents of the development.

Preim update

In September 2017 we were delighted to announce the very first communal green spaces had been handed over from Crest Nicholson to the Tadpole Garden Village Community Interest Company (TGVCIC).

As a result, the maintenance of these communal spaces is now funded through the estate charge that, as residents and TGVCIC members, you pay.

Working with Crest Nicholson, Preim – as your managing agent – identified snagging issues prior to the handover of these communal areas. We are now working with the newly-formed TGVCIC Environmental Working Group to ensure these snags are rectified, including re-planting of trees, hedge trimming and edging of footpaths.



Going forwards, Preim will work with the TGVCIC Steering Committee and the Environmental Working Group to continue to review new communal areas due to be handed over. Each of these areas will be maintained by Bristol based, grounds maintenance company Cut and Clear.
