

Catching the Bus



There is an excellent bus service operating in North Swindon, with both Stagecoach and Thamesdown services providing frequent and good value bus travel to Swindon Town Centre and surrounding areas.

There are three bus stops in Tadpole Garden Village. They are located at William Morris Way, beside Tadpole Farm Academy school and at Greene Street, near the pond. The number 4 service, operated by Stagecoach, stops at all three bus stops. Getting on at any stop in Tadpole Garden Village will bring you straight to Swindon Bus Station via St Andrew's Ridge and Cricklade Road in just 25 minutes.

The no. 4 operates every day except Sunday, and departs approximately every 30 minutes. On Sundays, the Thamesdown no. 11 is extended to run from nearby Oakhurst and Redhouse to the Town Centre, stopping at Tortworth Road and Millgrove Street, roughly 10 minutes' walk from Tadpole Garden Village. Service no. 15/15A also stops at Tortworth Road and Millgrove Street, from Monday to Saturday, travelling to Swindon Bus Station.



Bus Tickets

One way single fares on the no. 4 service start from as little as £1.40. An Adult Day Rider fare bought from Stagecoach costs just £3.50, and is valid on all bus services in Swindon operated by both Stagecoach and Thamesdown.

The cheapest and easiest way to travel by bus is to obtain a Stagecoach or Thamesdown smartcard, onto which you can load unlimited weekly and monthly TravelPass tickets. TravelPass allows unrestricted travel on all Stagecoach and Thamesdown buses the Swindon urban area, with prices starting from £14.50 for a 1-week TravelPass. You do not need to replace your smartcard when your ticket runs out, simply top it up with a new ticket online. Stagecoach smartcards can be bought online or on the bus.

If you plan on using the bus less frequently, then the Stagecoach app lets you pay for and download single and return tickets for the no. 4 service onto your smartphone. Simply show the driver your screen when you board you don't have to carry cash or worry about having exact change.

Free Bus Pass

As one of the travel options contained within the Travel Voucher, you can use your £50 Travel Voucher towards the cost of a 4 Week TravelPass. See your Travel Voucher for more details on how to claim this.

Stagecoach App:

The Stagecoach bus app helps to make your journey hassle-free. You can check live times so you know exactly when your bus will arrive, use your phone's GPS to find the nearest bus stop, use the journey planner to get to your destination with ease and even buy m-tickets on your phone. You can download the app by scanning the QR code below, and it works with all iOS and Android phones.

Bus service no. 4 provides a direct connection from Tadpole Garden Village to Swindon Bus Station, which is less than 5 minutes' walk from Swindon Train Station. Swindon train station is also accessible by bike and is pproximately 25 minutes' cycle from Tadpole Garden Village. The station has 160 cycle parking spaces with CCTV. Cycles can also be carried on trains free of charge, however most trains

The station has 24 hour car parking available. Daily parking charges start from £8.40.



Services from the station run to all major centres in the region, including Reading, Bristol and London.



It is easy to travel around Tadpole Garden Village and North Swindon by walking or cycling. Existing local pedestrian and cycle routes provide direct routes to key destinations. A dedicated cycle path has also been installed along Tadpole Lane to improve walking and cycling access. Sustrans National Cycle Route 45 also runs along Tadpole Lane west which connects to Cricklade and the Cotswold Water Park, as well as Swindon town centre.

The cycle route map (opposite) shows the pedestrian and cycle network around Oakhurst and Redhouse. Tadpole Garden Village links to this network. Green spaces will • Halfords, 2 Fleming Way, Swindon, SN1 2NN Tel: also be in abundance at Tadpole Garden Village and these will be linked by pedestrian/cycle routes to allow easy access for residents.

Existing primary schools, secondary schools, local shops and parks are all within walking and cycling distance from Tadpole Garden Village. All your basic provisions and leisure requirements can be reached within a mile walk (18 minutes) or cycle (7 minutes).

When completed, Tadpole Garden Village will have its own community facilities with local shops, a pub, a new primary school, healthcare facilities, allotments, play areas and

the new Nature Park – all linked via a comprehensive pedestrian and cycle network to ensure easy access to residents.




